Please note:

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel “Gliss Extra 2022” if due to the Coronavirus (Covid-19) situation the decision or recommendation of the national/local Government does not agree to conduct such an event or if the travel restrictions into and out of Estonia will block the Teams for an unexpected period of time.

Skaters are advised to seek advice from their relevant government agencies, travel and medical providers regarding travel to any destination country and any restrictions in place. These can change at short notice.

The Organizers cannot accept skaters from the countries, which are on the Estonian isolation list.

GLISS EXTRA 2022 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2021 and all respective ISU Communications for figure skating and the technical requirements of the Estonian Skating Union for the season 2022/2023.

The ISU Judging System shall be used in all categories.

REGISTRATION OF ENTRIES

Each **club** has the right to enter competitors in any category and class. *However, the Organizer shall have a right to limit the number of skaters from invited clubs and shall apply the "first come, first serve" principle.* Entries must be submitted in a written form (see *Entry form*). Please provide your contact information (e-mail, phone) on the entry form.

Entry forms must be submitted by **September 19, 2022**.

ENTRY FEE (paid before September 24, 2022):

Single Skating with one program: 75€

Single Skating with two programs: 90€

Late ENTRY FEE (paid after 24 September and before 3 October):

Single Skating with one program: 85€

Single Skating with two programs: 100€

Each club has to pay **100%** of the total amount for its participants **right after the entry form confirmation**, but not later than **October 3, 2022**.

The competitor is included in the entry list only after a 100% payment and from that moment can only be substituted by another skater if an emergency cancellation occurs.

We kindly ask the clubs to make one payment for all its participants.

- All registration-related procedures (annulment, changes) must be submitted to the organizer in written form as soon as possible, but no later than **October 3, 2022** to the e-mail: karmen@tvuk.eu
- In case a skater has been entered in the competition, but cannot participate, she/he can be replaced by another skater in the same category and class.
The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason, except when the Organizer has to reduce the entries.

AWARDING

Medals or trophies shall be awarded to the first three standings of each category/class. All competitors shall receive a diploma and present at the awarding ceremony.

PROTESTS

Each team has the right to file a protest. Protests must be submitted to the Referee of the relevant event in writing immediately after the event and

not later than 30 minutes after the end of the segment. Protests against incorrect mathematical calculation may be filed until 24 hours after the completion of the competition concerned.

Protests may be filed by Competitors or the club's official representatives. Upon the submission of the protest a protest fee of 50 EUR must be paid. The referee's decision is final.

No protests against evaluations by Referees, Judges and the Technical Panel (Technical Controller, Technical Specialists) of Skaters' performances are allowed. Please read ISU Rule 123.

MUSIC

CD's can be used (**do not use MP3 format**). Music (equipped with the full name of the competitor, club and category) must be submitted to the announcer's desk before the relevant event and picked up from the same place after the event.

RESPONSIBILITY

In accordance with the ISU constitution, Rule 119, all participants act at their own Responsibility.

THE CODE OF ETHICS

All officials (skaters, coaches, judges, chaperons) must follow ISU Communication 2342.

JUDGES

Each participating club may nominate one judge of at least National category to the Competition. In case of too many judge entries, the organizer will draw the panels of judges after the deadline.

Coaches are not allowed to act as Judges. In case a judge is sent by a competitor/club, the latter is responsible for the judge's transportation and accommodation expenses.

However, **accommodation compensation** in the amount of up to EUR 30 per night is available for invited judges upon the presentation of a hotel receipt (addressed to Uisuklubi Gliss MTÜ, Kotzebue 9-19). Invited Judges will also be granted with daily allowance.

Judge entries must be submitted by **September 19, 2022**.

PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

Competitors are asked to send their planned elements by e-mail to karmen@tvuk.eu by **October 6, 2022** at the latest. The Sheet must be filled according to the ISU element abbreviations for the season 2022/2023

TIME-SCHEDULE

The competition will start on Thursday, October 13, 2022 and will end on Sunday, October 16, 2022. A time schedule will be sent to all participating Members soon after the Entry deadline.

The time schedule will also be available at the Organizer's website www.tvuk.eu.

MANDATE

All participating clubs are asked to send their final entry forms for the draw **by October 12, 12 p.m.**

DRAWS

An ISU electronic draw shall be conducted on **October 12, at 4 p.m.** to draw the starting orders of all categories.

STARTING ORDER

Starting orders will be available at the Organizer's website www.tvuk.eu after the Electronic Draw.

In the categories with 2 programs, the starting order for the free program shall be the reversed result of the short program.

INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in Gliss Extra 2020, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.
